CLASS DESCRIPTION:

Want to add sparkle, light, shadow and texture to your art quilts? Have your design concepts pop? Your colors flow like rivers? Come to the Art Quilt Dimensional Stitching class and learn how to use stitching in new and exciting, non-traditional ways.

In this class, we will take traditional linear, fill and dimensional embroidery stitches and learn how with to use them in unique and amazing ways to express life's true textures. Go home with a working sample of each of the new art quilt dimensional stitching techniques being presented in this workshop.

SUPPLIES:

- 4- Fat Quarters in coordinated fabrics (2-should read as solids, and 2- small to medium prints)
- 18" x 18" piece of light weight batting
- Safety pins for basting
- Chalko-Liner – fabric marker
- #11 or #12 Crewel hand sewing needles
- Optional - Thimble
- Optional - Needle Threader
- Masking Tape
- 10 - Hanks of 6 strand cotton embroidery floss in complimentary and contrasting colors
- Optional - Threads to experiment with (i.e. pearl cottons, metallic)
- Small embroidery, regular sewing and paper scissors
- Cutting board, and rotary cutter
- Ruler – 6"x24" or 3"x24"
- Pencil/Eraser
- Paper – Note taking
- Glue stick
- Freezer Paper
- Ironing board & iron
