We'll cut, paste, paint, dip and dabble in search of our own magic carpet of color, where the colors of our deepest personal expression can be found. Along the way we will capture all that we've learned into a personalized COLOR MAGIC JOURNAL a record of the territory we've visited for each participant to take along on his or her next color discovery tour.

This workshop trains your eyes to see in a new way, and is guaranteed to enable you to see a more color-full world than you ever saw before.
