

Cooking Up New Fabrics!

CLASS DESCRIPTION: Take that blah piece of white fabric and spice it up with a FABRIC PAINT MARINADE. The recipes are easy and you will learn the secrets of the great fabric chefs. Using easy to obtain and use supplies you will be able to create a feast of painted fabrics to be used in your next quilt. Never have to wear masks, measure powders or spend hours rinsing dyed fabrics again!

SUPPLIES:

- ❑ 1- Plastic spray bottles/ large 2 Cup minimum
- ❑ 2- Plastic pour bottles/ large 2 Cup minimum
- ❑ 8- Gallon size plastic zip lock bags
- ❑ Glass measuring cup
- ❑ Tablespoon measuring spoon - not plastic
- ❑ 4 - 1 yard pieces Ready to dye or pre-washed/ dried cotton fabric
- ❑ Plastic sheeting or drop cloths for drying table
- ❑ 4-6 large trash bags
- ❑ Optional* Coarse Salt; various leaves; dry spaghetti, rice, open canvases
- ❑ Paper Towels
- ❑ Rubber or vinyl gloves
- ❑ Masking tape; paper scissors
- ❑ Paint Brushes of various sizes and other painting tools (Bring items that you may have around your home to experiment; at a minimum you may use kitchen sponges & Qtips)
- ❑ Ice cube tray and small recycled plastic bowls (for palette)
- ❑ Iron/Ironing board

***Note: There is a \$15 materials fee for providing students with 2- 2oz bottles of Createx Airbrush Paints; and additional paints for classroom use.**
