

Double Quilt Applique

In this workshop you will learn two machine applique techniques that are not only easy to achieve but will open new doors to your creativity.

CLASS DESCRIPTION:

- ▶ The first technique enables you to create dynamic backgrounds quickly and easily. Pick a favorite shape, sandwich two pieces of fabric together and the fun begins
 - ▶ Secondly, you will learn how to make and use small quilt sandwiches to create foreground elements to add to your quilted backdrop.
- You will leave the workshop with one small work underway and some cases completed.

SUPPLIES:

- ❑ 2 - 18 x 22" pieces of fabrics to be used in combination to create a quick and easy background
- ❑ Quilt Back fabric 24x26 (a small amount of this will be pulled from back and seen on top)
- ❑ Coordinating fabric scraps of several sizes
- ❑ 1 piece of batting 24" Square (light weight- Hobbs/Heirloom, Warm& Natural)
- ❑ Batting scraps of several sizes (light weight)
- ❑ Sewing machine in good working condition. Machine should have zig-zag capability and an appropriate foot for this stitching/ cording foot
- ❑ Bernina users should bring #21 foot if you have one
- ❑ Yarns for couching
- ❑ Beads/ Buttons (optional)
- ❑ Basic sewing supplies
- ❑ Regular sewing and decorative threads
- ❑ Several safety pins for basting
- ❑ Masking Tape
- ❑ Duckbill Appliqué scissors
- ❑ Cutting board, ruler and rotary cutter
- ❑ Iron and ironing board
- ❑ Pencil, Fine Line Sharpie permanent black marker
- ❑ Drawing and Tracing/Freezer Paper

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
