



## COLOR BOOK – GETTING STARTED

**There are only two basic supplies you need to get started creating your own color book.**

**The first is a sketchbook.** This sketchbook should contain lots of blank pages of a good quality paper. I like to make mine small enough to travel so I use a 7"x5" size. When selecting your don't go larger than 12"x9".

**Secondly,** pens, pencils are needed.

All the additionally items listed below are things you will collect and want to use and add to your color book as it grows.

- ❑ Magazines, Catalogs (i.e. Hancock Fabrics), picture books to cut up. (pick up any advertisement magazine for an area or city with lots of art galleries, i.e. New York, Sante Fe, LaJolla, or San Francisco, Seattle)
- ❑ Construction paper or colored papers
- ❑ Fabric scraps
- ❑ Paper scissors
- ❑ Glue stick
- ❑ Color wheel for reference
- ❑ 4x6 white index cards
- ❑ Fine line markers or pens that are fun to write with
- ❑ Water color set (kids quality) or water color pencils
- ❑ Paint Brushes
- ❑ Small paint mixing palette
